


THE COUNTERING RADICALIZATION CONTINUOUS PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT Training



Youth work professionals from each partner country participated in a week-long workshop in Schwerin, Germany in April, to test the Continuous Professional Development Training Curriculum.

The completely new curriculum will empower youth professionals and other front-line staff to deal with the threat of radicalization and to use readily available digital media tools and platforms.

The training started with background information and discussions about different social media channels, their effect and typical user profiles, gradually advancing to the elements in video production and then a hands-on exercise where the participants created their own short films and it received a very positive feedback from all the participants.
